Mechanic I – Maintenance Department

Incumbent serves as Mechanic I for Maintenance Department, responsible for assisting with the maintenance and repair of all equipment at GSD/GSWMD.

Key Responsibilities:

- Repairs and maintains wastewater plant equipment, including pumps, valves, and motors.
- Performs general and preventative maintenance for department shop and various job sites, ensuring efficient work environment.
- Performs electrical work, such as repairing wiring, circuits, and electrical apparatuses.
- Assists Master Mechanic with more advanced repairs as needed.
- Provides aid and assists other mechanics in performance of duties as needed.
- Keep work area clean, organized and compliant with safety standards.
- Operates a variety of equipment, hand and power tools including, but not limited to fork lift, overhead crane, power saw, and other equipment and tools as needed.
- Performs related duties as assigned.

Requirements and Qualifications:

- Indiana Driver's License required; the ability to obtain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL)
