Municipal Waste Driver

The Municipal Waste Driver is responsible for operation GSD vehicles to collect and transport solid waste along assigned routes.

Key Responsibilities:

- Operate GSD garbage trucks to collect solid waste on assigned routes.
- Follow establish routes and schedule to ensure timely waste pickup.
- Assist with loading and unloading waste materials when necessary.
- Perform routine vehicle inspections and ensure proper maintenance and cleanliness
- Load trash into the back of the sanitation trucks using manual and mechanical methods.
- Report any mechanical issues, route obstructions, or unsafe conditions to management.
- Comply with all local, state, and federal vehicle operation laws and safety regulations.
- Complete required logs, reports, and inspection forms.
- Communicate effectively with team members and supervisors
- Adhere to all safety rules and wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Provide courteous service to the public when applicable.
- Performs related duties assigned.
